1. Introductions
2. Review of morning meeting with UA evaluation team members Erin Peacock & Kim Fielding. Chair and subcommittee chairs met with UA to discuss priorities and evaluation plan. Suggestions include:
 - Take inventory to identify existing activities within tobacco and nutrition/physical activity communities
 - Identify which of these activities fall under the two CDC logic model objectives and the organizations doing them
 - Identify members from these organizations to update committee members on their activities. Also identify the evidence-based data on their activities. This will enable us to report back to CDC the specific activities that fall under our Comp Cancer goals that are already underway as well as their progress.
 - Identify gaps that may exist or opportunities for us to assist these advocacy groups
 - Extend our reach by providing/promoting this information to all tobacco advocates and nutrition/physical activity advocates
 - Extend our assistance to other Comp Cancer committees who may benefit from this information. For example, information on the disparities among pregnant smokers may benefit the disparities committee.
 - Extend our assistance by participating in symposiums, health fairs, commission meetings and providing a presence on other committees.
 - Explore sun safety and alcohol objectives listed in Comp Cancer Plan to see if assistance can be provided to these advocacy groups
 - Contact the ADHS Behavioral Health Office to learn how the Comp Cancer alcohol objectives are being met
3. UA evaluation team will provide the committee an assessment tool in April to collect this data and will guide us on producing the report.

4. Discussion among committee members included:

- Contacting TEPP for list of contractors, providers
- Quarterly meetings instead of monthly once the UA assessment tool is received
- Tapping into existing data like Vital Statistics which collect data on pregnant smokers
- Attend upcoming CTFA, Trust Commission and Disparities Committee meetings

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
